





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

09 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 August 2024 at around 2:42 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 3:58 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **27 families** or **85 persons** were affected in **Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **27 families** or **85 persons** sought temporary shelter at **Education Training Center School** in **Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros** Occidental (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 15 houses were damaged; of which, 10 are totally damaged and five (5) are partially damaged in Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱306,272.88 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱190,442.88 from DSWD and ₱115,830.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
