

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

09 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 August 2024 at around 2:42 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 3:58 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **27 families** or **85 persons** were affected in **Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **27 families** or **85 persons** sought temporary shelter at **Education Training Center School** in **Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **15 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 16 (Poblacion), Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱306,272.88** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱190,442.88** from **DSWD** and **₱115,830.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
