





DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City

09 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 04 July 2024 at around 4:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 5:12 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total **14 families** or **61 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of three (3) families or 11 persons sought temporary shelter in one (1) evacuation center in Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **11 families** or **50 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex D).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **14 families** or **61 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City** (see Annex E).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of five (5) houses were damaged; of which, three (3) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Fairview, Baguio City (see Annex F).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱430,312.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱290,312.00 from DSWD and ₱176,500.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex G).
