

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol

31 January 2025, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 08 August 2024 at around 11:30 AM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol. The fire was declared out at around 1:20 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **15 families** or **88 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **47 persons** sought temporary shelter in **Brgy. Covered Court** in **Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol** (see Annex B).

#### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **seven (7) families** or **41 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

#### c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **15 families** or **88 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol** (see Annex D).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **14 houses** were damaged; of which, **eight (8)** are **totally damaged** and **six (6)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Nocnocan, Talibon, Bohol** (see Annex E).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱237,735.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱115,000.00** from **DSWD** and **₱122,735.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
