

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato

as of 25 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 September 2024 at around 8:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Tubak, Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato between the groups of Commander Montaser Palencia of 105th base command of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front-Bangsamoro Islamic Armed Forces (MILF-BIAF) and Esmael Macasasa of the National Guard Defense of MILF-BIAF which resulted in the displacement of families and persons in the area.

A total of **92 families** or **460 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).
