





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Peñablanca, Cagayan

as of 20 September 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On September 17, 2024, at around 8:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Sitio Pallay, Barangay Baliuag, Peñablanca, Cagayan. This confrontation involved government forces and the Komiteng Rehiyon-Cagayan Valley of the Communist Terrorist Group (CTG). The situation subsequently escalated, resulting in a hot pursuit operation in the neighboring barangays of Lapi, Minanga, and Nanguilattan.

A total of 2,736 families or 10,944 persons are affected in four (4) barangays in Peñablanca, Cagayan (see Annex A).
