



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City

as of 15 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On September 14, 2024, a fire broke out at Aroma Street, Barangay 105, Happyland, Tondo, Manila City. The fire commenced at approximately 11:41 AM and was declared extinguished at 6:23 PM.

The Local Government Unit (LGU) of Manila City, through its Manila Department of Social Welfare (MDSW), has estimated that the fire has affected a total of 1,950 families, comprising approximately 7,800 individuals. Assessments and validations are ongoing.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in the National Capital Region through its Disaster Response and Management Division (DRMD) conducted a Rapid Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) aimed to obtain updates and assess the need for additional assistance. Furthermore, efforts were made to ensure the availability of food and non-food items to support the immediate needs of the affected populace.

A total of **1,950 families** or **7,800 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City (see Annex B).

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 2,994 FFPs available at DSWD FO NCR.
