I. Situation Overview

On 06 September 2024 at around 8:45 PM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 11:00 PM.

A total of 102 families or 441 persons are affected in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

A total of 73 houses were damaged; of which, 72 are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).
