I. Situation Overview

On 03 September 2024 at around 1:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Florentino St., in Brgy. Catbangen, City of San Fernando, La Union. The fire was declared out at around 2:30 AM.

One house was totally damaged in Brgy. Catbangen, City of San Fernando, La Union (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}8,790.50\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}5,647.50\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}3,143.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
