



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 04 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2024 at around 9:22 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 4, Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 10:28 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) X

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **59 families** or **211 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **26 families** or **130 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Underground Government Facility** in **Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **23 houses** were damaged; of which, **20** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱225,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex D).
