





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City

as of 23 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 19 September 2024 at around 5:58 AM, a fire incident occurred at Upper San Carlos Heights, Purok 5, Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 8:10 AM.

One (1) family or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

One (1) family or four (4) persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

One (1) house was partially damaged in Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱22,252.40 worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, ₱10,252.40 from DSWD and ₱12,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
