

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City as of 23 September 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 19 September 2024 at around 5:58 AM, a fire incident occurred at Upper San Carlos Heights, Purok 5, Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City. The fire was declared out at around 8:10 AM.

**One (1) family** or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

**One (1) house** was **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Irisan, Baguio City** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱22,252.40** worth of assistance was provided to the affected family; of which, **₱10,252.40** from **DSWD** and **₱12,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
