





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Losad, Sabangan, Mountain Province

as of 19 September 2024, 6AM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 08 September 2024 at around 2:30 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Liwang in Brgy. Losad, Sabangan, Mountain Province. The fire was declared out at around 5:15 AM.

A total of seven (7) families or 19 persons are affected in Brgy. Losad, Sabangan, Mountain Province (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **four (4) families** or **11 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of seven (7) houses were damaged; of which, four (4) are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Losad, Sabangan, Mountain Province (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P121,652.59** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
