## I. Situation Overview

On 05 September 2024 at around 1:00 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. N. Sering, Socorro, Surigao del Norte. The fire was declared out at around 3:00 AM.

A total of two two (2) families or four (4) persons are affected in Brgy. N. Sering, Socorro, Surigao del Norte (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Outside Evacuation Center**

There are **two (2) families** or **four (4) persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. N. Sering, Socorro, Surigao del Norte (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱30,800.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱10,880.00 from DSWD and ₱20,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
