

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Pansol, Calamba City, Laguna

as of 18 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 September 2024 at around 3:30 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Pansol, Calamba City, Laguna.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **66 families** or **236 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pansol, Calamba City, Laguna** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **14 families** or **58 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Pansol, Calamba City, Laguna** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **52 families** or **178 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **66 families** or **236 persons** displaced in **Brgy. Pansol, Calamba City, Laguna** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **55 houses** were damaged; of which, **41** are **totally damaged** and **14** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Pansol, Calamba City, Laguna** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱535,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** to the affected families (see Annex F).
