



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Poblacion Sur, Don Carlos, Bukidnon

as of 28 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 June 2024 at around 11:11 AM, a fire incident occurred at Purok 12, Brgy. Poblacion Sur, Don Carlos, Bukidnon. The fire was declared out at around 12:05 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) X

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **28 families** or **104 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Poblacion Sur, Don Carlos, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

21 families or 80 persons sought temporary shelter in Municipal Evacuation Center in Brgy. Norte, Don Carlos, Bukidnon (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center
 Seven (7) families or 24 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population A total of 28 families or 104 persons were displaced in Brgy. Poblacion Sur, Don Carlos, Bukidnon (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **23 houses** were damaged; of which, **18** are **totally damaged** and **five (5)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Poblacion Sur, Don Carlos, Bukidnon** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱192,824 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families composed of ₱31,024.00 from DSWD and ₱161,800.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
