I. Situation Overview

On 26 September 2024 at around 3:40 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tacos, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 4:19 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of nine (9) families or 36 persons are affected in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are nine (9) families or 36 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Barangay Hall in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of eight (8) houses were damaged; of which, six (6) are totally damaged and two (2) are partially damaged in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}60,203.47\$ worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Unit (LGU) to the affected families (see Annex D).
