

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Zapote III, Bacoor City, Cavite as of 11 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 September 2024 at around 11:52 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kaunlaran, Brgy. Zapote III, Bacoor City, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 2:13 PM.
