

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flash Flood Incident in Brgy. Dungos, Tulanun, North Cotabato

as of 04 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 26 August 2024 at 6:00 AM, SOCCSKSARGEN Region will be partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers and thunderstorms due to Southwest Monsoon. Possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms. Light to moderate winds will prevail from southwest direction and the wave height of coastal waters will be slight to moderate.

On the same day, a flash flood incident was experienced in Brgy. Dungos, Tulanun, North Cotabato due to the combined effects southwest monsoon and localized thunderstorms.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **156 families** or **780 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Dungos, Tulanun, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **111 families** or **555 persons** who sought temporary shelter in **Brgy. Covered Court** in **Brgy. Dungos, Tulanun, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **45 families** or **225 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

A total of **156 families** or **780 persons** were displaced in **Brgy. Dungos, Tulanun, North Cotabato** (see Annex D).
