





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Antique

as of 13 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 12 September 2024, the Southwest Monsoon triggered moderate to at times heavy rains across several regions, including Palawan, Occidental Mindoro, Western Visayas, the Negros Island Region, BARMM, Zamboanga Peninsula, and SOCCKSARGEN. These conditions potentially led to flash floods or landslides in some of these areas.

On the same day, several municipalities in the province of Antique reported flooding.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 157 families or 511 persons are affected in 11 barangays in Antique (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **100 families** or **316 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **eight (8) evacuation centers** in **Antique** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **nine** (9) families or 31 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are 109 families or 347 persons displaced in Antique (see Annex D).

1. Standby Funds

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 121,572 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 50,424 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 71,148 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 111,715 FFPs available at DSWD FO VI.
- ₱279.27 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FO VI warehouses.
