





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Brgy. Sinunuc, Zamboanga City

as of 31 August 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 29 August 2024 at 4:00 PM, partly cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorm in the rest of the country.

On the same day, a flooding incident was experienced in Brgy. Sinunuc, Zamboanga City due to localized thunderstorm.

A total of **14 families** or **55 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Sinunuc, Zamboanga City** (see Annex A).

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 14 families or 55 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Sinunuc Covered Court in Brgy. Sinunuc, Zamboanga City (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 14 houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Sinunuc, Zamboanga (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P9,940.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
