





DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Paracelis, Mt. Province

as of 04 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 05 August 2024, due to localized thunderstorm affecting Northern Luzon, two (2) barangays in the Municipality of Paracelis, Mt. Province experienced flooding.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 31 families or 116 persons are affected in two (2) barangays in Paracelis, Mt. Province (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

Two (2) families or 10 persons temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of two (2) houses were damaged; of which, one (1) is totally damaged and another one (1) is partially damaged in Paracelis, Mt. Province (see Annex C).
