

# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Paracelis, Mt. Province

as of 04 September 2024, 6PM

## I. Situation Overview

On 05 August 2024, due to localized thunderstorm affecting Northern Luzon, two (2) barangays in the Municipality of Paracelis, Mt. Province experienced flooding.

A total of **31 families** or **116 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Paracelis, Mt. Province** (see Annex A).

## III. Status of Displaced Population

### Outside Evacuation Center

**Two (2) families** or **10 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were damaged; of which, **one (1)** is **totally damaged** and another **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Paracelis, Mt. Province** (see Annex C).
