

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Tornado Incident in Basista, Pangasinan

as of 15 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2024, a tornado incident was experienced in barangays Bayoyong and Navalat in Basista, Pangasinan which caused damaged to properties and resulted in the displacement of families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **27 families** or **109 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Basista, Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

III. Damaged Houses

A total of **27 houses** were damaged; of which, **10** are **totally damaged** and **17** are **partially damaged** in **Basista, Pangasinan** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱351,748.20** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱267,748.20** from **DSWD** and **₱84,000.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex C).
