





# DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Tornado Incident in Basista, Pangasinan

as of 15 September 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2024, a tornado incident was experienced in barangays Bayoyong and Navalat in Basista, Pangasinan which caused damaged to properties and resulted in the displacement of families.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **27 families** or **109 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in **Basista**, **Pangasinan** (see Annex A).

## III. Damaged Houses

A total of 27 houses were damaged; of which, 10 are totally damaged and 17 are partially damaged in Basista, Pangasinan (see Annex B).

#### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}351,748.20\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}267,748.20\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}84,000.00\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex C).
