


DSWD DROMIC Report #11 on the Effects of Southwest Monsoon, Tropical Storm "Ferdie", Tropical Depression "Gener", and Tropical Storm "Helen" as of 18 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

Issued on 18 September 2024 at 5:00 PM, Tropical Storm "Helen" is about to exit the Philippine Area of Responsibility.

HAZARDS AFFECTING LAND AREAS

Refer to Weather Advisory No. 33 issued at 5:00 PM today for the heavy rainfall outlook due to the Southwest Monsoon enhanced by GENER and HELEN.



Severe Winds

The Southwest Monsoon enhanced by "Gener" and "Helen" will also bring strong to gale-force gusts over the following areas (especially in coastal and upland areas exposed to winds):

- Today: Zambales, Bataan, Pampanga, Bulacan, Metro Manila, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, Visayas, Zamboanga Peninsula, Northern Mindanao, Caraga, and Davao Region
- Tomorrow (19 September): Ilocos Region, Isabela, Aurora, Zambales, Bataan, Metro Manila, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, Bicol Region, Western Visayas, Negros Island Region, and Zamboanga Peninsula
- Friday (20 September): Batanes, Ilocos Region, Abra, Benguet, Aurora, Zambales, Bataan, Cavite, Batangas, Quezon, Occidental Mindoro, Marinduque, Romblon, and Kalayaan Islands.

HAZARDS AFFECTING COASTAL WATERS

24-Hour Sea Condition Outlook

Gale Warning is in effect over several coastal waters in the western seaboard of Central Luzon, the seaboard of Occidental Mindoro, and the western seaboard of Palawan including Kalayaan Islands. Sea travel in these waters is risky for small seacrafts, including all types of motorbancas.

Up to rough seas over the following coastal waters outside Gale Warning areas:

- 1.5 to 3.5 m: The seabards of Batanes and Ilocos Region; the eastern seaboard of Palawan (including seabards of Cuyo Islands); seaboard of Antique
- 1.0 to 3.0 m: The northern and eastern seaboard of Cagayan Valley; the remaining western seabards of Western Visayas; the western seaboard of Negros Island Region; the remaining seabards of MIMAROPA
- Mariners of small seacrafts, including all types of motorbancas, are advised not to venture out to sea under these conditions, especially if inexperienced or operating ill-equipped vessels.

Up to moderate seas over the following coastal waters outside Gale Warning areas:

- Up to 2.5 m: The eastern seaboard of Bicol Region; the southern seaboard of southern Quezon; the seaboard of Cagayancillo Islands; the northern and eastern seabards of Northern Samar; the eastern seaboard of Eastern Samar; the seaboard of Caraga Region; the eastern seaboard of Davao Oriental; the seaboard of Southern Leyte, the southern seabards of Negros Island Region and Central Visayas; the seaboard of Zamboanga del Norte; the seaboard of Northern Mindanao.
- Mariners of small seacrafts, including all types of motorbancas, are advised not to venture out to sea under these conditions.

TRACK AND INTENSITY OUTLOOK


- “Helen” is forecast to move northwestward for the entire forecast period and exit the PAR region in the next three hours.
- “Helen” is forecast to remain as a tropical storm and may gradually weaken over the East China Sea.

The center of the eye was estimated based on all available data 930 km East Northeast of Extreme Northern Luzon (24.6 °N, 129.9 °E) while moving Northwestward at 40 km/h with maximum sustained winds of 85 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 105 km/h.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **356,801 families** or **1,257,650** are affected in **1,667 barangays** in **Regions II, III, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XII, CAR, and BARMM** (see Annex A).



III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **18,005 families** or **70,214 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **572 evacuation centers** in **Regions II, III, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, IX, X, XII, and BARMM** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **14,833 families** or **64,550 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex E).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **32,838 families** or **134,764 persons** displaced in **Regions II, III, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, IX, X, XII, and BARMM** (see Annex F).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **1,368 houses** were damaged; of which, **231** are **totally damaged** and **1,137** are **partially damaged** in **Regions II, V, VI, VII, IX, X, XII, and BARMM** (see Annex G).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱35,182,996.97** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱30,759,546.55** from **DSWD**, **₱4,102,795.30** from the **Local Government Units (LGUs)**, **₱136,180.00** from the **Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs)** and **₱184,475.12** from **other Partners** (see Annex H).
