

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato as of 26 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 September 2024 at around 8:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Tubak, Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato between the groups of Commander Montaser Palencia of 105th base command of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front-Bangsamoro Islamic Armed Forces (MILF-BIAF) and Esmael Macasasa of the National Guard Defense of MILF-BIAF which resulted in the displacement of families and persons in the area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **155 families** or **648 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

There are **155 families** or **648 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱110,050.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex C).
