

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City as of 15 September 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On September 14, 2024, a fire broke out at Aroma Street, Barangay 105, Happyland, Tondo, Manila City. The fire commenced at approximately 11:41 AM and was declared extinguished at 6:23 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **1,737 families** or **6,948 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **1,737 families** or **6,948 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱1,287,504.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
