





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City

as of 15 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On September 14, 2024, a fire broke out at Aroma Street, Barangay 105, Happyland, Tondo, Manila City. The fire commenced at approximately 11:41 AM and was declared extinguished at 6:23 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 1,737 families or 6,948 persons are affected in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 1,737 families or 6,948 persons currently taking temporary shelter in three (3) evacuation centers in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P1,287,504.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
