





DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion) San Carlos City, Negros Occidental

as of 08 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 September 2024 at around 8:45 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 11:00 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 106 families or 326 persons are affected in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are 106 families or 326 persons currently taking temporary shelter at the Poblacion Covered Court in Brgy. 4 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 77 houses were damaged; of which, 76 are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P393,822.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
