

## DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion) San Carlos City, Negros Occidental

as of 08 September 2024, 6AM

### I. Situation Overview

On 06 September 2024 at around 8:45 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 11:00 PM.

### II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **106 families** or **326 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### Inside Evacuation Center

There are **106 families** or **326 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Poblacion Covered Court** in **Brgy. 4 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

### IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **77 houses** were damaged; of which, **76** are **totally damaged** and **one (1)** is **partially damaged** in **Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex C).

### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱393,822.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
