

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City as of 09 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2024 at around 9:22 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 4, Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 10:28 PM.

In response, the DSWD through its Field Office in Region X together with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cagayan de Oro City, promptly provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **59 families** or **211 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **40 families** or **120 persons** took temporary shelter in **Underground Government Facility** in **Brgy. 17, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **23 houses** were damaged; of which, **20** are **totally damaged** and **three (3)** are **partially damaged** in **Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱225,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex F).
