

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City

I. Situation Overview

On 26 September 2024 at around 3:40 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City. The fire was declared out at around 4:19 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **nine (9) families** or **36 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **nine (9) families** or **36 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Hall** in **Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **eight (8) houses** were damaged; of which, **six (6) are totally damaged** and **two (2) are partially damaged** in **Brgy. Tacas, Jaro, Iloilo City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱137,036.43** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱76,8323.96** from **DSWD** and **₱60,203.47** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex D).
