





# DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Zapote III, Bacoor City, Cavite

as of 12 September 2024, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

On 10 September 2024 at around 11:52 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kaunlaran, Brgy. Zapote III, Bacoor City, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 2:13 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of 839 families or 4,195 persons are affected in Brgy. Zapote III, Bacoor City, Cavite (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are 728 families or 3,640 persons currently taking temporary shelter in 17 evacuation centers in Brgy. Zapote III, Bacoor City, Cavite (see Annex B).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **111 families** or **555 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

### c. Total Displaced Population

There are 839 families or 4,195 persons displaced in Brgy. Zapote III, Bacoor City, Cavite (see Annex D).

### IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of \$\mathbb{P}\_3,567,654.18\$ worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, \$\mathbb{P}\_3,206,320.00\$ from DSWD and \$\mathbb{P}\_361,334.18\$ from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex E).
