
DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato

as of 25 October 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 September 2024 at around 8:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired at Sitio Tubak, Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato between the groups of Commander Montaser Palencia of 105th Base Command of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front – Bangsamoro Islamic Armed Forces (MILF-BIAF) and Esmael Macasasa of the National Guard Defense of MILF-BIAF, which resulted in the displacement of families and individuals in the area.

On 19 October 2024 at around 8 AM, a re-engagement between the same groups took place in the same area.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **219 families** or **953 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **130 families** or **527 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Barangay Pagangan Covered Court** in **Aleosan, North Cotabato** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **89 families** or **426 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **219 families** or **953 persons** still displaced in **Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **four (4) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. Pagangan, Aleosan, North Cotabato** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱110,050.00** worth of assistance was provided by the **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
