# I. Situation Overview

On 14 September 2024 at around 11:41 AM, a fire incident occurred at Aroma Street, Barangay 105, Happyland, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:23 PM.

A total of **2,006 families** or **6,726 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

## **III.** Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

There are **2,006 families or 6,726 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

## IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).

# V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱4,260,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
