





DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental

as of 09 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 September 2024 at around 8:45 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 11:00 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **106 families** or **326 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **106 families** or **326 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Poblacion Covered Court** in **Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 98 houses were damaged; of which, 97 are totally damaged and one (1) is partially damaged in Brgy. 5 (Poblacion), San Carlos City, Negros Occidental (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **P986,084.64** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
