

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental

as of 04 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2024 at around 12:39 AM, a fire incident occurred at Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental. The fire was declared out at around 4:24 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **74 families** or **215 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There were **28 families** or **101 persons** who sought temporary shelter in **one (1) evacuation center** in **Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **27 houses** were damaged; of which, **24 are totally damaged** and **three (3) are partially damaged** in **Brgy. Carmen, Cagayan de Oro City, Misamis Oriental** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱195,615.00** worth of assistance from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** was provided to the affected families (see Annex D).
