





# DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City

as of 26 September 2024, 6PM

#### I. Situation Overview

On 10 August 2024 at around 9:22 PM, a fire incident occurred at Zone 4, Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City. The fire was declared out at around 10:28 PM.

# II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **59 families** or **211 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex A).

# III. Status of Displaced Population

#### **Inside Evacuation Center**

A total of **40 families** or **120 persons** took temporary shelter in an **Underground Government Facility** in **Brgy. 17, Cagayan de Oro City** (see Annex B).

# IV. Damaged Houses

A total of 23 houses were damaged; of which, 20 are totally damaged and three (3) are partially damaged in Brgy. Consolacion, Cagayan de Oro City (see Annex E).

#### V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱746,077.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱521,077.00 from DSWD and ₱225,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex F).
