

DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite

as of 06 November 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 07 August 2024 at around 1:16 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Wawa in Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 3:55 AM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **563 families** or **2,786 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **413 families** or **1,280 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **seven (7) evacuation centers** in the **City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **150 families** or **1,506 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **563 families** or **2,786 persons** displaced in the **City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex D).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱12,999,355.80** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱12,468,545.80** from **DSWD**, **₱507,870.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** and **₱22,940.00** from **other Partners** (see Annex E).
