

DSWD DROMIC Report #4 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City as of 03 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 14 September 2024 at around 11:41 AM, a fire incident occurred at Aroma Street, Barangay 105, Happyland, Tondo, Manila City. The fire was declared out at around 6:23 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,006 families** or **6,726 persons** are affected in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **2,006 families** or **6,726 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **three (3) evacuation centers** in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **12 houses (temporary housing buildings)** were **totally damaged** in **Brgy. 105, Tondo, Manila City** (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱26,064,195.99** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex D).
