

DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Zapote III, City of Bacoor, Cavite

as of 06 November 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 10 September 2024 at around 11:52 AM, a fire incident occurred at Sitio Kanluran, Brgy. Zapote III, which also affected the neighboring Brgy. Talaba II in the City of Bacoor, Cavite. The fire was declared out at around 2:13 PM.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **932 families** or **4,460 persons** are affected in **two (2) barangays** in the **City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **695 families** or **3,167 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **18 evacuation centers** in the **City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex B).

b. Outside Evacuation Center

There are **237 families** or **1,293 persons** temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **932 families** or **4,460 persons** displaced in the **City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **797 houses** were damaged; of which, **777** are **totally damaged** and **20** are **partially damaged** in the **City of Bacoor, Cavite** (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱29,599,035.59** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱12,468,545.00** from **DSWD**, **₱15,118,247.59** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)**, **₱759,880.00** from **Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)**, and **₱1,252,363.00** from **Other Partners** (see Annex F).
