

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Armed Conflict in Peñablanca, Cagayan

29 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 17 September 2024, at around 8:30 AM, an armed conflict transpired in Sitio Pally, Barangay Baliuag, Peñablanca, Cagayan. This confrontation involved government forces and the Komiteng Rehiyon-Cagayan Valley of the Communist Terrorist Group (CTG). The situation subsequently escalated, resulting in a hot pursuit operation in the neighboring barangays of Lapi, Minanga, and Nanguilattan.

In response, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), through its Field Office in Region II, provided relief assistance to support the immediate needs of the affected families and individuals.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **2,736 families** or **10,944 persons** were affected in **four (4) barangays** in **Peñablanca, Cagayan** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱ 2,131,192.80** worth of assistance from **DSWD** was provided to the affected families (see Annex B).
