





DSWD DROMIC Report on the Capsized Motorized Banca in Romblon

11 September 2024, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 26 August 2024 at around 4:00 AM, the MBCA URIMY motorboat and one unnamed boat colored white and blue plying the Boracay-Caluya Island route capsized due to strong wind and rough waves.

On the following day, the Local Government of San Jose, Romblon received the information that two (2) survivors were found at the Ocean Edge Resort in Sitio Inihawan, Brgy. Lanas. The Philippine Coast Guard and the Municipal Police Station (MPS) immediately launched a search and rescue (SAR) mission to locate and rescue the passengers.

An additional eight (8) survivors were rescued in the area between Caluya Island Antique and San Jose, Romblon.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **13 persons** are affected in **Rombion** (see Annex A).

III. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱113,122.00 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱79,122.00 from DSWD, ₱14,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU), and ₱20,000.00 from Non-governmental Organization (NGO) (see Annex B).
