



DSWD DROMIC Report on the Fire Incident in Brgy. Tangub, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental

11 September 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 21 August 2024 at around 2:25 PM, a fire incident occurred in Brgy. Tangub, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental. The fire was declared out at around 3:45 PM. Source: DSWD Field Office (FO) VI

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **eight (8) families** or **41 persons** were affected in **Brgy. Tangub, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **eight (8) families** or **41 persons** temporarily stayed with their relatives (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of six (6) houses were totally damaged in Brgy. Tangub, Bacolod City, Negros Occidental (see Annex C).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱91,363.52 worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, ₱64,363.52 from DSWD and ₱27,000.00 from the Local Government Unit (LGU) (see Annex D).
