

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flash Flood Incident in Makilala, North Cotabato

26 January 2025, 6PM

I. Situation Overview

On 27 August 2024, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers and thunderstorms caused by localized thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms.

On the same day at 4:15 PM, a flash flood incident was experienced in Brgy. Malabuan and Brgy. Luna Sur, Makilala, North Cotabato due to localized thunderstorms.
