

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Maramag, Bukidnon

11 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 23 August 2024 at 4:00 AM, partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rain showers or thunderstorms may have brought possible flash floods or landslides during severe thunderstorms in the rest of the country.

On the same day, a flooding incident due to localized thunderstorms occurred in the municipality of Maramag, Bukidnon particularly in the flood-prone barangays namely; Base Camp, Dagumbaan, and Panalsalan.

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **306 families** or **1,421 persons** were affected in **three (3) barangays** in **Maramag, Bukidnon** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **five (5) families** or **20 persons** sought temporary shelter at the **Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management (BDRRM) Office** in **Maramag, Bukidnon** (see Annex B).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of **two (2) houses** were **totally damaged** in **Maramag, Bukidnon** (see Annex D).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱589,468.00** worth of assistance was provided to the affected families; of which, **₱339,048.00** from **DSWD** and **₱250,420.00** from the **Local Government Unit (LGU)** (see Annex E).
