# I. Situation Overview

On 06 October 2024 at 10:39 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 79<sup>th</sup> Infantry Battalion of Philippine Army and alleged members of the Communist Party of The Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in Brgy. Macasilao, Calatrava, Negros Occidental.

There are **100 families** or **371 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Covered Gym** in **Brgy. Macasilao, Calatrava, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).
