



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Brgy. Macasilao, Calatrava, Negros Occidental

as of 09 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 06 October 2024 at 10:39 AM, an armed conflict transpired between the 79th Infantry Battalion of Philippine Army and alleged members of the Communist Party of The Philippines-New People's Army (CPP-NPA) in Brgy. Macasilao, Calatrava, Negros Occidental.

A total of **100 families** or **371 persons** are affected in **Brgy. Macasilao, Calatrava, Negros Occidental.** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

Inside Evacuation Center

There are **100 families** or **371 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Brgy. Covered Gym** in **Brgy. Macasilao, Calatrava, Negros Occidental** (see Annex B).

IV. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of **₱61,000.00** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Annex F).
