



DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Effects of Easterlies

as of 05 October 2024, 6AM

I. Situation Overview

On 01 October 2024, several barangays in the municipalities of Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur and Banaybanay, Davao Oriental experienced flooding due to the Easterlies.

On 02 October 2024, the Easterlies caused flooding in various municipalities in the province of Maguindanao del Sur.

On 03 October 2024, flashflood incidents were also experienced in the municipalities of Arakan, North Cotabato and Lambayong, Sultan Kudarat. Source: DOST-PAGASA Daily Weather Bulletin and DSWD Field Offices (FOs) XI and XII

II. Status of Affected Areas and Population

A total of **37,487 families** or **163,145 persons** are affected in **79 barangays** in **Regions XI, XII,** and **BARMM** (see Annex A).

III. Status of Displaced Population

a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **26 families** or **117 persons** currently taking temporary shelter at the **Malibatuan Covered** in **Region XII** (see Annex B).

 b. Outside Evacuation Center There are 25 families or 125 persons temporarily staying with their relatives or friends (see Annex C).

c. Total Displaced Population

There are **51 families** or **242 persons** displaced in **Region XII** (see Annex D).

IV. Damaged Houses

A total of seven (7) houses were damaged; of which, two (2) are totally damaged and five (5) are partially damaged in Region XII (see Annex E).

V. Cost of Humanitarian Assistance Provided

A total of ₱15,900.00 worth of assistance was provided by the Local Government Units (LGUs) to the affected families (see Annex F).

1. Standby Funds

- ₱123.41 million Quick Response Fund (QRF) at the DSWD Central Office.
- ₱6 million available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- ₱41.6 million available in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of Easterlies.

2. Prepositioned FFPs and Other Relief Items

- 396,334 FFPs available in Disaster Response Centers; of which, 190,069 FFPs are at the National Resource Operations Center (NROC), Pasay City and 206,265 FFPs are at the Visayas Disaster Resource Center (VDRC), Mandaue City.
- 214,305 FFPs available at DSWD FOs XI and XII.
- 1.32 million FFPs in other DSWD FOs which may support the relief needs of the families affected by the effects of Easterlies.
- ₱1.8 million worth of other FNIs at NROC, VDRC, and DSWD FOS warehouses.
